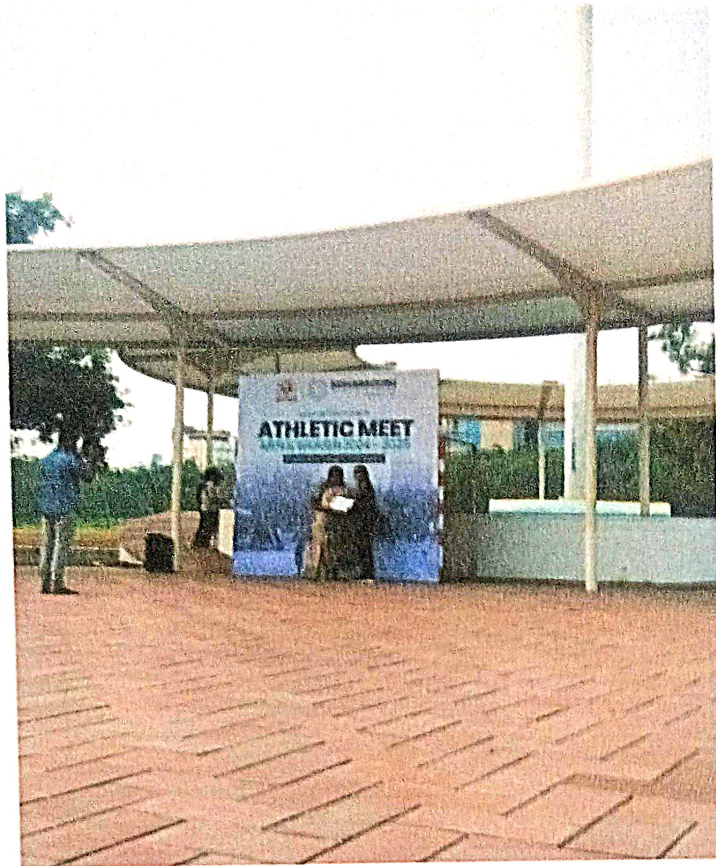

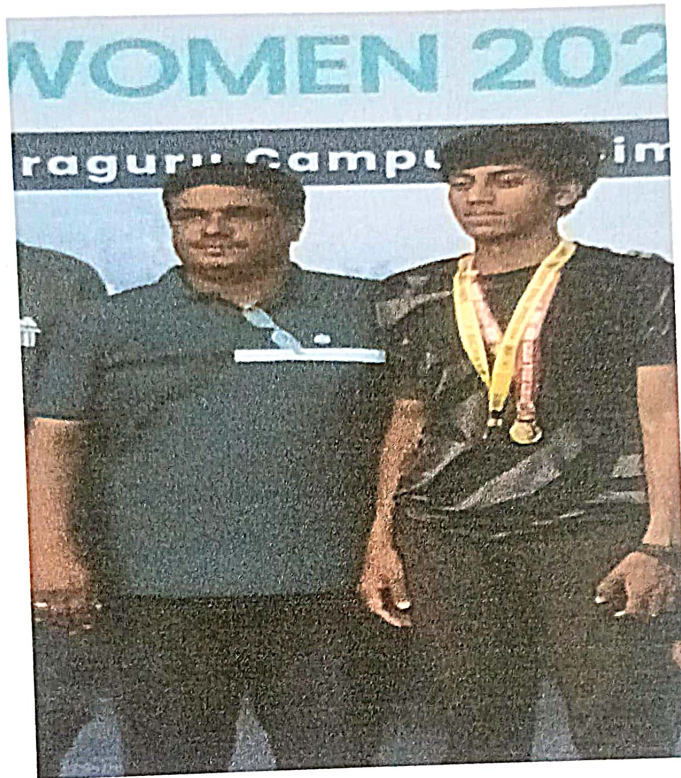

## TIVIN JONATHAN G

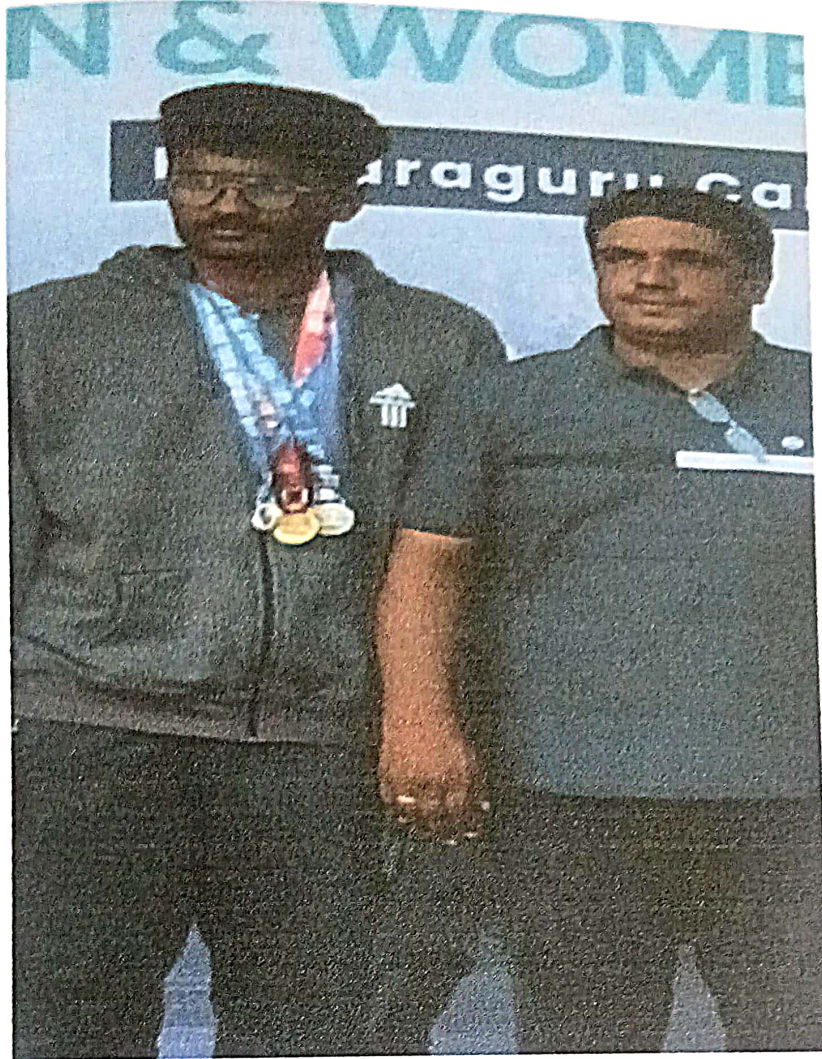
